INFORMATION ON TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ACTIVITIES

Addendum

At its meeting of 12 May 1995, the Committee on Customs Valuation agreed that greater transparency of technical assistance activities, pursuant to Article 20.3 of the Agreement on Implementation of Article VII of the GATT 1994, would be ensured if the information prepared for the Technical Committee on Customs Valuation (TCCV) on such activities were also made available as WTO documents.

This document contains a report providing information on technical assistance activities carried out by the Secretariat of the World Customs Organization (WCO).

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ACTIVITIES ON CUSTOMS VALUATION ORGANIZED BY THE WCO SECRETARIAT

Due to the prevailing conditions caused by the COVID 19 pandemic, it was not possible to carry out all the missions planned for the period. Necessary arrangements have been made to continue supporting Members with the use of technology.

Since the $50^{th}/51^{st}$ virtual sessions of the TCCV, which was held from 12 to 14 October 2020, three virtual workshops, as detailed in the table below, have been held. The sub-regional workshop mentioned in the table has been jointly organized by the WCO and Japan for five countries of the Southern Africa Region.
