



## REPORT (2020) OF THE COMMITTEE ON TECHNICAL BARRIERS TO TRADE

1. The Committee held its 80<sup>th</sup>, 81<sup>st</sup> and 82<sup>nd</sup> regular meetings on 26-27 February, 13-14 May<sup>1</sup> and 28-30 October 2020, respectively. The 80<sup>th</sup> and 81<sup>st</sup> meetings were chaired by Mr Sung-Hwa Jang (Korea), and the 82<sup>nd</sup> was chaired by Mr Laurence Sandral (Australia).

2. During these meetings<sup>2</sup>, the Committee:

- a. heard statements from Members regarding measures taken to ensure the implementation and administration of the TBT Agreement under Article 15.2. In total, since 1995, 145 Members have submitted at least one such statement;
- b. with respect to notifications<sup>3</sup>:
  - i. received 1638 *new* notifications from Members;
  - ii. received 1129 *follow-up* notifications (addenda, corrigenda, revisions) from Members;
- c. with respect to specific trade concerns:
  - i. discussed 57 *new* specific trade concerns;
  - ii. discussed 156 *previously raised* specific trade concerns;
- d. took note of the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Review of the Implementation and Operation of the TBT Agreement under Article 15.3<sup>4</sup>;
- e. held thematic sessions in February on Good Regulatory Practice<sup>5</sup>, and on Conformity Assessment Procedures<sup>6</sup>; and in October on Technical Assistance<sup>7</sup> and on Technical Regulations (mandatory marking and labelling)<sup>8</sup>; and,
- f. at the time of writing, the Committee had also scheduled, for 8 December 2020, a thematic session on conformity assessment procedures; the sharing of experiences on COVID-19; as well as a workshop on the role of gender in the development of standards.
