The Plant Variety Rights Regulations 2023 support the Plant Variety Rights Act 2022 in creating modern Plant Variety Rights (PVR) regime in New Zealand by making changes that meet responsibilities to Māori under the Treaty of Waitangi, implements extended exclusive right provided for by UPOV 91, the most recent international agreement on PVR protection, and meet international trade obligations under the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans Pacific Partnership (CPTPP).
