Description of content:</b> Notice of proposed rulemaking and announcement of public meeting on 17 January 2024 - The Energy Policy and Conservation Act, as amended (" <a href="#">EPCA</a> "), prescribes energy conservation standards for various consumer products and certain commercial and industrial equipment, including <a href="#">electric motors</a> . In this notice of proposed rulemaking ("NOPR"), DOE proposes new energy conservation standards for a subset of electric motors, expanded scope electric motors, expressed in terms of average full-load efficiency, and also announces a public meeting to receive comment on these proposed standards and associated analyses and results.  DOE will hold a public meeting on Wednesday, 17 January 2024, from <a href="#">10:00 am to 4:00 pm Eastern Time</a> , in Washington, DC. This meeting will also be broadcast as a webinar.
